We operate 4 entities from our base in Naples, FL. All focus on fostering learning – some through tutoring; others through summer camps; and others through writing, videography and other teaching modalities.

We are looking for interns (short-term and long-term) to help us in the following areas. In return for helping us in the following unpaid positions, we would provide learning opportunities, marketable job experience credentials, networking and more. Most of these positions would be handled remotely / long-distance (i.e., you would remain at your location).

- **new web site manager** - This includes maintaining an array of web, mobile device and social media pages.
- **applications developers** - need to develop several applications for tablet and phone use; these also need to be maintained and updated.
- **weather camps nationwide** - We are looking to establish new campsites (possibly at your university). We also need counselors, computer programmers, chaperones and individuals to handle other support functions. For participation at a campsite distant from you, we are working to be able to provide a stipend and/or covered room and board.
- **writing matters** - as prolific writers, we need people to help research and ghost write for us. This includes articles for web site publication, blog entries, meteorological post-mortems and even sections of an online weather guide for the public. This may also include research/fact checking to verify facts and other non-weather information as well as creation of imagery and videos for online use.
- **climatology** - we are developing a catalog of significant / historical weather events and need to obtain factual information, written in condensed format to provide a valid geographical- and event-based, easily updatable, data base.
- **research** - we are also engaged in meteorological (or related) research projects. Projects underway include a global assessment of tropical cyclones, improved waterspout forecasting off the New England coast, the feasibility of developing a national water pipeline system. a study of the south Florida sea breeze circulation and a South Florida ground fog climatology. We will work with individuals on their self-initiated research projects, as well.
